

# Analysis of data for the Academic Year 2016-2017

Ifield School uses a range of different measures to assess the progress of our pupils. As with other Special Schools in Kent, Ifield School is using a data system called Pupil Asset to collate our Summative Assessments in academic subjects. This enables us to monitor our pupils' progress and to identify any interventions that may be required.

The Kent Association of Special Schools (KASS) data group formulated an algorithm to be used as a starting point to benchmark expected rates of progress for pupils within KASS Schools for academic subjects.

The colour bands used on Pupil Asset are as follows:-

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For the purpose of the tables below, colour bands relate to pupils' progress from their various starting points.

For average VA, 0.0 would represent expected progress. For Legacy-Style Average VA. 100.0 would represent expected progress. In short, value added represents the contribution a school makes to a child's learning compared to the average for pupils with similar starting points.

The yellow band has been included within the acceptable range of progress because the vast majority of pupils had achieved more than half of the required elements within this expectation and therefore remain on track to make at least expected progress over time.
