Year 7 Catch Up Funding

Year 7 Catch-up funding is an amount of money the government pays to the school for each Year 7 pupil who enters the school below age-expected levels. The level of funding is based on the number of pupils on roll at the January census. The funding is intended to support additional intervention that will enable the pupil to 'catch up' with his or her peers in English and Maths.

For pupils at Ifield the funding is used to support their transition into Year 7 and to ensure that they continue to make good or better progress, especially in Literacy.

Speech & Language Therapy Interventions	£6710	100% of Year 7 pupils achieved expected or better progress in NC S&L. 67% of Year 7 pupils achieved above expected progress in NC S&L.
Summer Club	£288	Improved engagement in literacy through cross-curricular learning opportunities.
