We welcome Adam Holloway, MP for Gravesham since 2005. A former Army Officer, Adam has also enjoyed a successful career as an investigative journalist and reporter with ITN. In 1991, he produced an award -winning documentary, 'No Fixed Abode,' spending three months sleeping rough on the streets of London, uncovering the plight of the city's homeless population. Earlier this year, during the February Parliamentary Recess, he spent a further 7 nights under the awnings of St Paul's Church, Covent Garden for a special addition of ITV's 'Tonight' programme with poignant insights, observations and conclusions.

Adam has a genuine interest in highlighting and addressing local issues including those of families who have children with ASD and related conditions.
