# English:

In English pupils will be developing their writing skills through a range of different genre. E.g. Story writing, recounts and instructions.

We will practise our handwriting daily using a cursive script.

Pupils will be improving their phonic skills through Little Wandle Letters and Sounds.

Our daily reading sessions will include a range of tasks E.g. Guided reading, written comprehension, independent reading and spelling/grammar skills.

We will be following a number of texts which link to our topic; growing and changing.

# Physical Education:

Robin Class will be completing a range of team games in PE; developing their teamwork and decision making skills.

On our PE Enrichment afternoon we will be Archery.



Pupils will be following the Numicon maths scheme at their own level and will be learning about place value, addition, subtraction and shapes.

# History:

Pupils will be learning about a range of historic events in time and develop their ability to order these. They will also be ordering events in their own

lives

#### Science:

Pupils will be learning about scientific properties and changing materials in science. They will be completing a range of practical experiments.

#### Art:

Pupils will be creating their own self portraits as well as exploring the artwork of Leonardo Da Vinci.

#### Food Tech:

The pupils will be making a range of sweet and savoury dishes this term, focusing on pastry. Cooking is every Thursday morning. Please send a £1 donation every week on Wednesday for this activity.

### Life Skills:

This term we are developing our self help skills around the home including; making the bed, being safe in the kitchen and being responsible for our own belongings.

We will also have a weekly computing lesson, allowing pupils to upskill their ICT skills.

# PSHE (Personal, social and health education):

In PHSE, the pupils will be focusing on identifying qualities in themselves and key events in their own lives.

We will be following a scheme called PELICAN- promoting emotional literacy in Children with additional needs.
