This term our topic will be 'Animal Homes'. We will be incorporating this throughout our curriculum; providing opportunities for cross curricular learning. We are lucky enough to also be attending the Ifield Woodlands this term to conduct our own field research.

English:

In English pupils will be developing their writing skills through a range of different genre e.g. Story writing, recounts, instructions and non-fiction reports.

Pupils will be improving their phonic skills through Little Wandle Letters and Sounds.

Our daily reading sessions will include a range of tasks e.g. Guided Reading sessions and Individual Reading sessions.

We will be following a number of texts which link to our topic of animal homes such as Penguin small, Meerkat mail and Frozen planet.

Maths:

Pupils will be learning about multiplication and division, money, length, capacity and temperature in Maths.



Community based learning:

Pupils will be learning to observe, record and present human and physical features in the local area.



Science:

Pupils will be learning about living things and their habitats. Following our topic of animal homes.

Art:

Pupils will be exploring the use of different materials to create habitats they have learnt about in Science and Geography.

Food Tech:

The pupils will be identifying the food they eat each week and categorising these into the main food groups.



Life Skills:

This term we are developing our self help skills around the home including; making hot and cold drinks.

Computing:

We will also have a weekly computing lesson, allowing pupils to upskill their ICT skills.

PSHE (Personal, social and health education):

In PHSE, the pupils will be following a programme called Life Lessons where they learn about different aspects of personal hygiene and developing their emotional regulation.

Physical Education:

Woodpecker Class will be completing a range of team games in PE; developing their teamwork and decision making skills. On our PE Enrichment afternoon we will have Dance and Movement.



Religious Education:

In RE the pupils will be learning about Christians and what they believe in.



Geography

This term, the pupils will be comparing and contrasting the climate in different areas of the world.



Careers

This term the pupils will be researching different uniforms that people wear for their job. We will be holding a careers week commencing on the 26th February.
