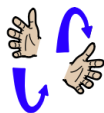


## Core signs for our topic this term.

Pupils will be developing their independence skills through managing their clothing needs by helping with dressing and undressing.

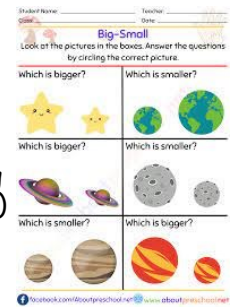
## Communication

Pupils will work on personalised speech and language targets. Pupils will be using a range of communication strategies, such as Intensive Interaction and use of E-Tran, Auditory Scanning books and switches.



## Maths

Magpie class will be exploring sequencing numbers and counting and sorting objects through comparing size (big and little) and weight (heavy and light).



## Topic

In our topic work this term, we will be focusing on consistent reactions to a variety of different sensory experiences provided by familiar activities, such as music, art, sensory cooking and sensory exploration.

## Employability

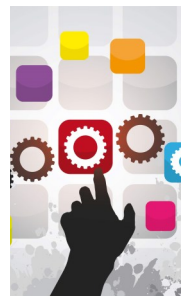
Magpie class pupils will be developing their understanding of one-step instructions and learning to carry out tasks, such as 'Press the switch'.
