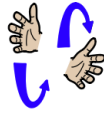

In Digital Skills students will use a range of control devices to cause a change of action.



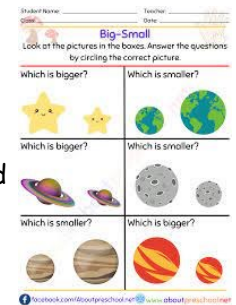
Communication

Students will be sharing their goals for the future, with support as well as sharing their individual preferences from a range of activities.



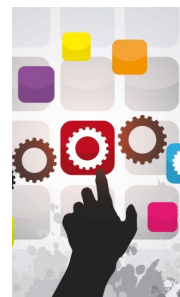
Physical Education:
