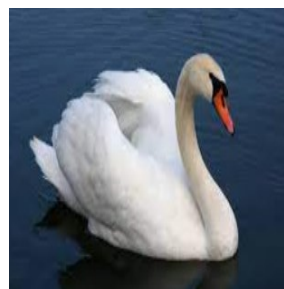

## Functional English

This term our theme will be Switch Off! We will be exploring Crossing the Line in English as well as various Staying Safe Online as our non-fiction text.

Pupils will be using these texts to explore different forms of formal and informal writing. The pupils will continue to develop their reading comprehension skills through guided reading.

Pupils will have regular opportunities to develop and practice their speaking and listening skills. Pupils will also be focusing on grammar and punctuation.



## Functional Maths:

This term pupils will be developing their problem solving skills by learning to recognise key information from a word problem and break it down into a number sentence. They will also practice their money and measurement skills.



## Digital Skills:

This term pupils will be learning about transacting online. Last term pupils learnt how to stay safe online and what a trusted website is which they will now be able to apply when learning how to make purchases online. This also links to our maths work meaning they will have opportunities to use their skills.

## PSHE/RSE:

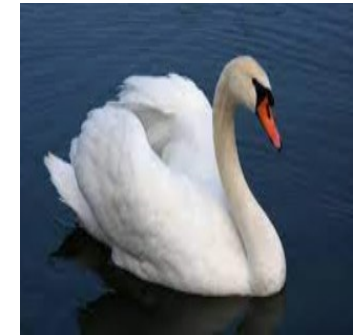
This term pupils will be learning about their right to be safe and how they can be safe in different situations. Pupils will develop their understanding of who they can contact if they do not feel safe and who could help them.

## Preparation for Adulthood:

This term pupils will be learning about nutrition. Pupils will be learning about meal time conventions which will involve skills such as setting up a table, eating with others, what a healthy plate looks like.

## Employability:

This term pupils will be learning about professional and organisational skills in the workplace. Pupils will learn how to read and complete a list that has been given to them. They will also develop confidence to work independently on familiar tasks.



## Physical Education:

Pupils will have a PE lesson every Monday. They will develop their gross motor skills and co-ordination. Please ensure your child has a named PE kit which can stay in school.



## Religious Education:

In R.E. pupils will be learning about the differences in belief about God and what this means for different people. They will explore the options and views of others and have opportunities for discussions around this.



## Sports Enrichment

PE Enrichment will be every Thursday afternoon. Pupils will choose an activity from a range including boxing, cycling, ice skating and others for the term.
