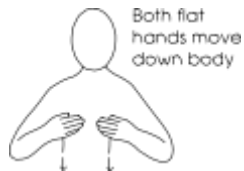


## Core signs for our topic this term.

picture

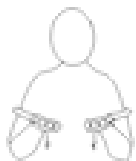


Queen

## Literacy and Phonics

In Literacy we will focus on the texts: 'Super Duper' by Sophy Henn, 'A superhero like you' by Dr Ranj and 'Amazing me, amazing you' by Christine McGuinness. We will continue to develop our writing skills with a focus on developing our sentences and how we can extend them.



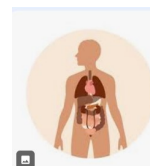
## Maths

In Maths this term we will be developing multiplication and division and starting to look at fractions and time.

We will continue to apply the skills we have learnt through developing our ability to answer problem solving questions, identifying operations needed to solve problems.

## Science

This term in Science, we will be learning about the body. We will be identifying, drawing and labelling parts of the human body. We also will be looking at parts of the body that are linked to senses and how these work.



## Computing

This term in Computing we will be exploring taking different pictures or photos of ourselves and focusing on how these can be edited using different software.



## Art and Design & Technology

In Art and Design we will be focusing on looking at ourselves, what features we have and how they might be different. We will start by trying to sketch out a self-portrait and then engage in using paper mache to make a 3D portrait. We will also look at some well known portraits by different artists.



## Food Tech:

In Food Technology we will be focusing on creating summer desserts.

We will be making fruit salad faces, smoothies and ice lollies.



## History

In History we will be learning about significant figures of history, such as Queen Elizabeth and Queen Victoria and how aspects of life may have changed. We will also be looking at clothing through the years and compare our clothing to those from the past.



## PSHE (Personal, social and health education) and RSE

In PSHE we will be looking at identifying special people in life and why they are special. We will also recognise the way families are special and what they mean to us. We will ask the question: 'What special things do you do with your family?' and share ideas.

## Physical Education

This term we will be focusing on:

### Athletics

Pupils will be developing a variety of skills, such as: running, throwing, jumping, balance, strength and flexibility. They will also think about how they can improve their skills further.

## Religious Education

Our key question we will be thinking about this term is:

'Which people are special and why?'. We will be thinking about values of friendship and family and contributing through discussions our thoughts and feelings on this subject.

## PE Enrichment

This term, PE Enrichment will be every Tuesday afternoon where pupils will access our pool for swimming lessons.



## Music

Pupils will learn about the musical genre: 'The Blues' and experience a variety of 'Blues' artists such as Little Richard and James Brown.

Pupils will have the opportunity to develop their keyboard skills to play chords and notes of the 12-bar blues.
