Intensive interaction, sensory circuit and sensory stories are daily interventions which meet students sensory needs and develop communication and interaction skills.



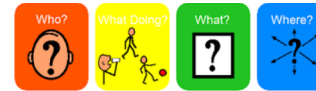
## Digital Skills

Students will learn to show care and concern for self. Owl class will use access control devices to build a sequence of events.



## Communication

Students will use communication boards to support their requests for items. There will be a personalised focus on Speech and Language targets to facilitate communication with a range of communication partners.



## Foundations for Maths

Owl class will demonstrate that they understand how to share part of a group of objects. Students will also identify measures using comparative language.



## EAD

Students will experience a range of sung and rap music throughout their music lessons. They will have the opportunity to create and make rhythms using a range of tuned and untuned instruments.



## Foundations for Literacy



Students will continue to develop their communication and literacy skills. Students will verbalise feelings of anger and happiness. Linked to this terms topic 'Watch Me' stories will include Bathroom Boogie by Clare Foges and This is me by George Webster.

## Employability

Students will identify a job they would like to do. They will recognise and respond to the routine of entering a workplace and identify some appropriate work clothes.



## Physical Education:

This term we will be participating in athletics. Focusing on gross motor skills through running, jumping and throwing events.
