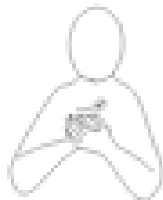

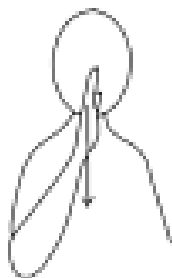

PSED

Our PSED learning this term will focus on health and prevention. We will be cleaning our teeth daily as part of our life skills focus. We will have the opportunity through imaginative play to role play going to the Dentist. If you have any photographs of your child visiting the dentist, please could you forward them to our office email address. Thank you.

Communication Interaction

We will continue to develop our personalised speech and language targets to facilitate early communication with a range of communication partners. The pupils will be supported to becoming more confident to initiate interactions with peers through a variety of turn taking games and play opportunities to enable sharing resources with reduced adult support.

Understanding of the World

This term Wren Class will be exploring and developing our reactions to things we hear, smell, touch and taste.

We will be continuing to develop our understanding when identifying parts of the body. This will be supported by developing our role play and imaginative play through playing doctors and dentists.

Expressive Arts and Design

This term we will be focusing on creating sculptures using lots of different mediums and mark making implements. We will be exploring different shapes made when sculpting.

Arts Week will be taking place this term week commencing 28.4.25, further details will be sent home in due course.

Food Technology

Each week pupils in Wren class will have opportunities to make their own food. This will take place in either Ifield Life on a Wednesday or on a Friday in either the classroom or Food Technology room.



Music

Every week we will have Gong Therapy and a music lesson. Pupils will experience the musical genre: The Blues, and a variety of artists such as Little Richard and James Brown. Pupils will have the opportunity to explore a variety of tuned instruments such as the keyboard and glockenspiel to access notes of the 12-bar blues.

Foundations for Literacy

This term pupils will continue to develop their communication through Objects of Reference, PECS, Makaton, Colourful Semantics and communication boards.

Our learning time will include: Attention Autism and the Curiosity Programme.

Pupils will continue to develop their fine motor, mark-making and handwriting skills through a range of activities, including Write Dance, Dough Disco and sensory trays. We will have story sessions daily including story sacks and sensory stories. Each student will share a story with an adult on either a 1:1 basis or in a small group.

Linked to this terms topic '3D Me' stories will include ; The Colour Monster by Anna Llenas , The Roar By Eoin McLaughlin and From Head to toe from Eric Carle.

Physical Education

This term we will be focusing on developing gross motor skills alongside hand/eye co-ordination and to continue our independent physical development targets. Wren class have enjoyed riding bikes in Term 4, we will be continuing to develop our bike riding skills in Term 5.

Foundations for Mathematics

Each week we will be focusing on a different mathematical concepts including: Counting, 1:1 correspondence, sequencing numbers, comparing the length and weight of objects and sorting activities e.g. by colour, shape or size.

Life Skills

The pupils will develop their life skills with the preparation of snack everyday, personal hygiene activities and activities to encourage social interaction and turn taking. We will continue developing independence as part of the Ifield Life Programme . Our life skills will focus on Health and Prevention, such as being able to clean teeth and knowing about the Dentist.

PE Enrichment

This term Wren Class will be visiting Gillingham Ice Rink on 24.4.25 & 1.05.25. The students will have the opportunity to continue to develop their confidence and skills on the ice. From wc 5.05.25 on Wednesdays Wren Class will be going to Meapa Gym. The students will have the opportunity to expand their gross motor skills using a variety of apparatus with the support of class team and a gymnastic instructor.
