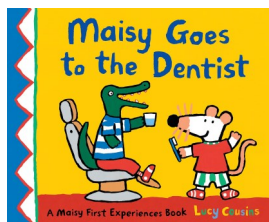
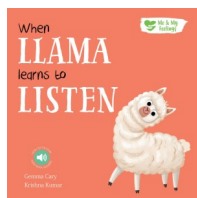
Homework and contact

Qualification Work

Maths

shop and students are given a chance to their skills to buy items from the shop as well as being a shop keeper and selling items to other students.

PE Enrichment
