During Term 5 we will be moving continuing with the units called Managing Own Money and Dealing with Problems in Daily Life. Homework and contact

Thank you for using the Home/School Journals, the comments we receive are really helpful. Reading or sharing a book with your child every night will really improve their literacy. Please, also ensure that they have the appropriate clothing (with name label) for activities. Conversations about the jobs of family members, what their duties are and what their day is like, are very useful for our ASDAN courses and enhances preparation for adulthood.

English

Students will continue to develop their spoken and written communication and will be working towards their ASDAN, Functional Skills or entry level qualifications.



Our core texts will reflect the theme of the term. This term we will be reading, listening to and watching *The King's Speech*.

We will continue to improve our spelling, grammar and punctuation throughout this term and looking at the different ways in which we can review and improve our work independently, including using a wider range of vocabulary and using our prefixes and suffixes correctly. We will be using a thesaurus to help us spell new words and use a range of vocabulary.

Qualification Work

All of our students will be working on ASDAN units in Personal and Social Development or Employability. We will also be working towards qualifications in English and Maths Functional Skills. The qualification work is embedded across our curriculum.

Maths

During our Maths lessons we will be using both the Numicon and White-Rose Maths curriculum and resources. Using both curricula enables the students to learn at their own level and in accordance with their own need.

This term we are looking at money and how to manage it. This links very nicely in with the 'Managing My Own Money' ASDAN unit.

We will also be revising time again this term. The students will be using both analogue and digital, so it would be helpful if you can work on time at home with your children. Even if it is just asking them what the time is.



Enrichment

We are offering students the choice between going to the Cyclopark, swimming at Cascades, going to the park music or an art enrichment activity based at Sixth Form on Friday afternoons. Please ensure that your young person brings the appropriate clothing & footwear.

Developing Independence

We will be looking at our skills in the kitchen, including knife skills, using equipment safely and working as independently as possible. There are very close links to Preparing for Adulthood and Enterprise lessons this term and all of these subjects will contribute to our ASDAN studies, preparation and portfolio work.

Options

Students are following one of the options subjects including Horticulture, Foodwise, Challenger Troop, Hair & Beauty or Performing Arts & Media. Work here will contribute to the ASDAN Accreditation.



Preparing for Adulthood

The focus for this term will be understanding different clothing needs, including clothing appropriate for the time of year and appropriate clothing for different occasions.

Digital Skills:



Digital skills for Term 4 will involve us exploring our new laptops and refreshing old skills and gaining new ones, so that we may be able to take our Functional Skills exam in Digital Skills next year. We will be learning how to navigate and use our laptops.

RSE/PSHE (Relationships and Sex Education/Personal, social and health education):

We will be looking at how we develop, maintain and manage social relationships. We will learn how to interact with others in everyday and familiar situations, as well as unfamiliar and how certain behaviours can impact on those around us.

Enterprise

During our Enterprise lessons we will be learning about a range of awareness events, celebrations, saint's days and major sporting events.

The students will have the opportunity to make a range of items connected to of different celebrations and key events.
