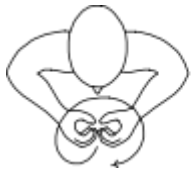

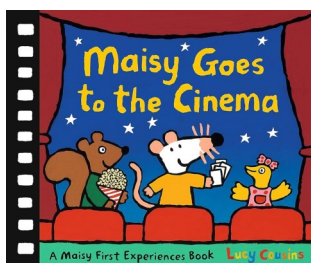
Homework and contact

Qualification Work

ASDAN qualification work is embedded across our curriculum. Students on the Personal Progress programme will be using New Creative Activities, Developing Skills for the Workplace and Personal Relationships.

Maths

This term we will be looking at sharing items and identifying how many items we need to be able to share them evenly between our groups of students. This will begin to develop our addition and division skills. This will also develop our confidence in the community as we can use these addition and division skills to be able to use money, count tickets and even counting the seats on the minibus.



PE Enrichment

For P.E Enrichment this term the students have been given a range of different enrichment activities to choose from. These will include going to a nature park (e.g Shorne/Jeskyns) Ifield woods, Music or Art. If there is an option you would like your child to do please let us know via the journal.

Developing Independence

This term we will be developing our skills to be able to use utensils and appliances such as kettles, toasters and blenders. We will do this by using these appliances in our food technology lessons. We will be making a variety of foods, drinks and ice lollies.
