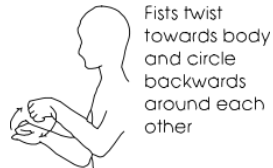

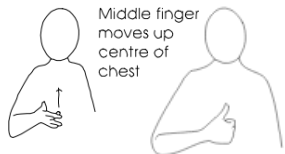

Curriculum information

Our topic this term will be 'Growing and changing'. We will be exploring this topic in different ways, throughout the various Subjects in our timetable. General Information

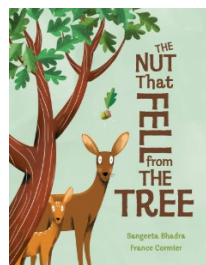

English:

In English, we will focus on adding punctuation to our written work, as well as improving our handwriting.

This term, we will also be working on making predictions and creating alternative endings. The students will explore and write their own non-fiction explanation texts.

We will be studying a range of texts, including *The Nut that Fell from the Tree* and *The Tadpole's Promise*, to support and inspire their writing.



Maths:

Pupils will continue using the White Rose Maths resources, answering word problems linked to the strand of Maths we will be focusing on. This term we will be developing pupils knowledge of Place value, addition and subtraction, fractions and time.



Careers

This term we will be researching our dream job and presenting this in front of the class. We will be developing a growth mindset, in preparation for the year ahead.



Art/DT:

In DT students will work in small groups to design, make and evaluate a product to protect an egg when dropped from a height.

Robin class will also explore different colours and how we can mix colours to make other colours.

Preparation for Adulthood



During term 1 Robin Class will be learning to independently look after our personal care needs.

Computing:

During computing, pupils will be exploring what technology is, the parts of computers and how computers work together. Pupils will also be comparing their home and school technology and how they differ.



PSHE (Personal, social and health education) and RSE:

This term students will be learning about families and people who cares for them. We will be looking at what makes our own families special; recognising similarities and differences in our class. They will also learn about what respectful relationships look like and how we can care for other people.

Physical Education:

Pupils will be experiencing a range of team sports including: Basketball, Cricket, Football and Tag Rugby. We will be developing our skill acquisition and understanding of how to play in a team, in preparation for an end of term inter house games competition. Which team will win the cup?

Religious Education:

In RE this term students will look at what can we learn from a variety of Sacred books.



Music

Pupils will learn to create their own Hook and Riff remix on either Garageband or using classroom instruments. Pupils will also develop their singing skills to learn a variety of Harvest themed songs.
