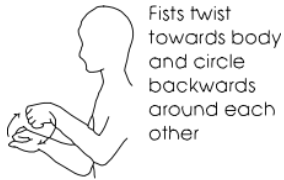

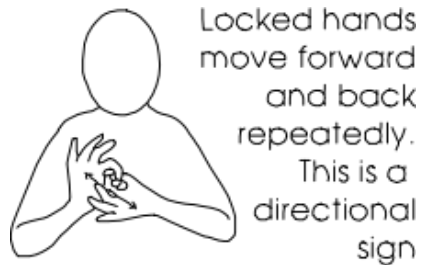

Students will also be exploring a range of skills such as engaging in creative activities and self-help and independence skills.

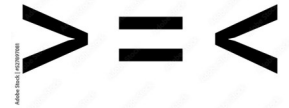
Attention Autism/ Communication

Students are taking part in daily Attention Autism sessions to expand on attention and engagement. Students are completing up to Stage 4. Pupils will be using sentence builders using colourful semantics and choice boards to expand their communication this term.



Foundations for Maths

Diamond class will be exploring a range of different concepts through activities.. Diamond class will be identifying different quantities and using different language to express this e.g. more or less.

This term students are focussing on showing care for one another and showing care for themselves. Students will use technology to show and respond to emotions.

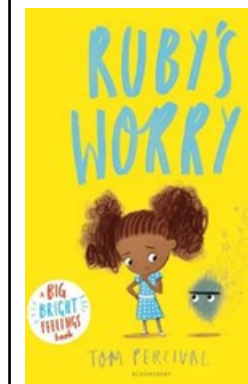
Monday Expressive Arts Options
