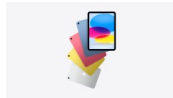
## Interventions

Intensive interaction, sensory circuit and sensory stories are daily interventions which meet students sensory needs and develop communication and interaction skills.



## Digital Skills

Students are using iPads and laptops to access Busy Things. They can play games and choose Maths and English activities such as counting and cause and effect buttons. They can create digital art images by using different tools such as the paint bucket and sprays.



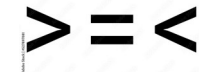
## Communication

Students will use communication boards to support their requests for items. There will be a personalised focus on Speech and Language targets to facilitate communication with a range of communication partners.



## Foundations for Maths

Students will be exploring a range of different concepts through maths activities. Owl class will be identifying different quantities and using different language to express this e.g. more or less, bigger and smaller. We will be practising money and time skills.



## EAD

Students will explore different materials in a variety of ways, to link into our topic of "Events" This will include creating decorations for various celebrations.



## Foundations for Literacy
