Curriculum information

This term, our learning will be centred around the exciting theme *Lights, Camera, Action!* In Computing and English, we will explore this topic through various creative projects. Our class book will be *The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark* by Jill Tomlinson,. In Food Technology, students will have the opportunity to design and make a variety of delicious seasonal dishes, developing their practical skills and creativity in the kitchen.

English

In English, we will be linking our learning to our focused topic: Lights, Camera, Action! We will begin looking at the text, 'The owl who was afraid of the dark', before exploring other texts which share the same theme. Pupils will be learning how to expand their descriptive writing of a setting,

We will be learning about non-fiction writing, in particular information linked to Owls. Pupils will be researching their own facts to produce pieces of non-fiction writing.



Maths

In Maths, students will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction and 2D shapes. Fractions and time, We will be using the White Rose resources to support the pupils to answer word problems linked to these strands of Maths.



Music

Pupils will learn to identify the function of music through encountering music for (but not limited to) Diwali, Remembrance Day, life events and Christmas. Pupils will also continue to develop their singing and/or instrumental skills to produce an ensemble performance for Christmas.



Food Technology

In Food technology students will make and evaluate a range of seasonal recipes e.g. toffee apples and mince pies and Christmas biscuits as well as learning how to make a delicious hot chocolate.



PSHE/RSE

This term students will be learning about being safe in relationships, in the community, at home and online.



Preparation for Adulthood

This term we will be looking at food hygiene along with health and safety when preparing and storing food.



Physical Education

In term 2, our curriculum area of focus will be gymnastics. Pupils will develop their strength, coordination and balance whilst learning new movement patterns. They will have opportunities for paired work and use of our gymnastics apparatus. Please ensure your child has a PE on a Wednesday.

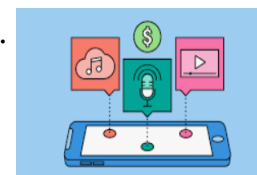
Religious Education
