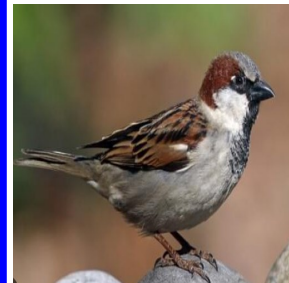

General Information

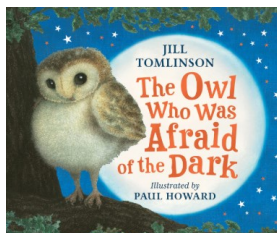

English:

In English we will continue to focus on adding the correct punctuation to our written work as well as improving our handwriting.

This term in English, we will be focusing on descriptions of settings. The students will also look at and write their own information texts about Owls.

We will be looking at various texts including 'The Owl that was afraid of the dark' to support their writing.



Maths:

In Maths, students will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction and 2D shapes. We will be using the White Rose resources to support the pupils to answer word problems linked to these strands of Maths.



Science:

In Science, they will learn about Light. Students will recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is an absence of light. They will recognise that the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.



Food tech:

In Food technology students will make and evaluate a range of seasonal recipes e.g. toffee apples and mince pies and Christmas biscuits as well as learning how to make a delicious hot chocolate.



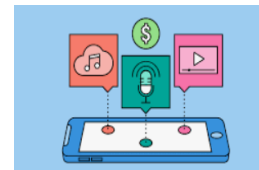
Lifeskills:

This term students will continue to look at keeping our classroom tidy including cleaning our own desks at the end of the day and placing rubbish into the correct bins in the classroom.



Computing:

The students will have a weekly computing lesson where they will learning about Creating Media.



PSHE (Personal, social and health education) and RSE:

This term students will be learning about being safe in relationships, in the community, at home and online.



Physical Education:

This term, students are continuing to build on their ball skills, refining and applying them within team games and small competitions. Through these activities, pupils are learning to work together, make quick decisions, and develop confidence in a supportive, yet competitive environment.

Religious Education:

In RE this term students will look at what can we learn from a variety of Sacred books. Also will we learn who are Christians and what do they believe?



History

In History we will research the Gunpowder plot and the historical figure Guy Fawkes. We will consider how and why we commemorate this event every year. Is this celebrated globally and why not? Also how do people celebrate it in Britain.



Music

Pupils will learn identify the function of music through encountering music for (but not limited to) Diwali, Remembrance Day, life events and Christmas. Pupils will also continue to develop their singing and/or instrumental skills to produce an ensemble performance for Christmas.
