

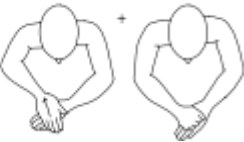
Core signs for our topic this term.

Celebration

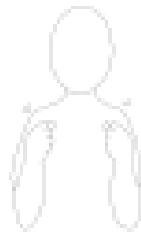
Hands twist at wrist

Maths

During our Maths lessons we will be using both the Numicon and White-Rose Maths curriculum and resources. Using both curricula enables the students to learn at their own level and in accordance with their own need.



This term we will continue to practice using our symbols correctly and understand their meaning. The students will be able to identify a range of different processes, which enables them to become more independent in their work.

Enrichment

We are offering students the choice of activities on Friday afternoons. The choices are Art, Music, the park, golf (driving range) or the gym. Please ensure that your young person brings the appropriate clothing & footwear.

Developing Independence

During Term Two we will be continuing to develop culinary skills for the home., including using proper hygiene and sanitation processes and being able to prepare and cook food. We have two new air fryers which we are exploring using.



Pop Up Shop

At Sixth Form students are running a Pop Up Shop during morning break. Students from all classes are supporting the running of the shop on a rota system. There are various good value snacks available to buy, supporting students with their independence and money handling skills.
