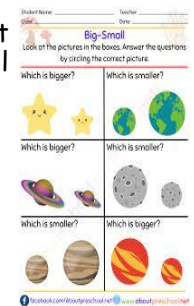
Communication

Students will work on personalised speech and language targets. They will be encouraged to communicate with a range of communication partners. They will engage in a number of activities, including, singing songs, Intensive Interaction and The Curiosity Programme.



Maths

Kingfisher class will be exploring now/next and finished. They will be making requests for desired objects and developing identifying behaviours, such as, Same and Different.



Topic

In our topic work this term, we are focussing on "Time Travelers". We will be engaging in music activities where we will create sound through banging and tapping and art activities where we will create simple brightly coloured pieces.



English



Students will be encouraged to wave and tap their arms, bounce or stamp their feet to simple rhythms in songs and rhymes. They will handle books, printed and digital media with interest.

Employability

Kingfisher class pupils will be focussing on developing their social skills through group activities, such as PE and turn taking games. They will learn to recognise and follow routines through now and next.

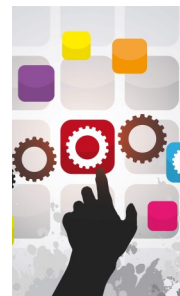
PSED/Citizenship/RSE
