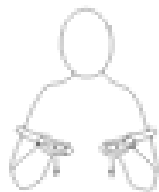

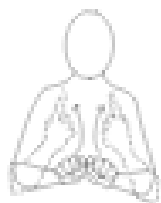

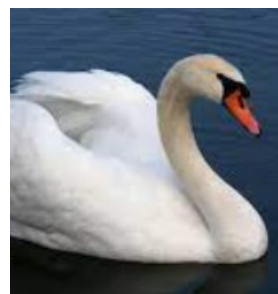

General Information

We hope you had a restful break and are all looking forward to an exciting term ahead. We have now established our routine and we work from our regular timetable on a weekly basis, unless there are any special events. This term, students will be exploring "Horrible Histories."

Maths

This term the children will practice problem solving skills, applying what they have learnt about number to solve simple addition and subtraction calculations. The children will also continue to develop their understanding of multiplying and dividing.

English

This term we will focus on Horrible Histories. The children will develop their retrieval and inference skills. They will continue to focus on punctuating their sentences correctly and extending simple sentences with a conjunction (for example: but, because, and). They will also explore adjectives and nouns so they can extend their sentences by adding an adjective to describe the noun.

Employability

This term children will practise skills to support them in the workplace. They will practise team building, problem solving and communication skills.



RE

In RE this term, pupils will be taught about Sikhism. They will learn about where Sikhs worship and what it means to have a belief.

We will try to visit the Gurdwara to embed the learning.

PSHE

In PSHE this term, pupils will be learning about our monarchy and identifying leaders. They will be taught about the UK voting system and the difference between a truth and a lie. They will be taught about rules and why there are rules in society.

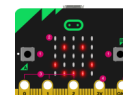

Digital Skills

The children will be learning skills linked with the Entry Level 3 Qualification. They will use programming software to control a Microbit. They will also continue to think about online safety.



Preparation for Adulthood

This term, pupils will be learning about self-care. They will be taught how to notice differences in their health and what medication is. They will be taught about different health conditions and how to manage them.



Physical Education:

PE will take place every Monday afternoon. This term, pupils will take part in structured swimming sessions focused on building confidence, improving swimming technique, and developing awareness of water safety. All activities will take place in a safe, supportive and enjoyable environment.

Art Award

Pupils take part in an Art accreditation every Friday morning. They rotate between Music, Art and Art in Nature every other term. Your child will change their activity in January and then again in April.

PE Enrichment

PE Enrichment will be every Thursday afternoon. Pupils will choose an activity from a range including archery, skiing, street dancing and tennis.
