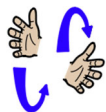

Ideas for home

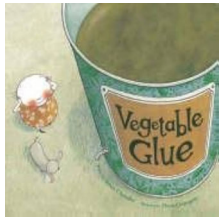
We would encourage you to read with your child at home when possible. We will be able to provide a selection of books and a reading record to accompany this.

English

This term in English, pupils will be exploring both fiction and non-fiction texts. Our focus story will be *Vegetable Glue* by Susan Chandler, alongside the non-fiction text *Growing Food* by Usborne.



Pupils will learn about different genres and develop their understanding of how to write effective instructions. They will practise their story writing skills, as well as create persuasive posters encouraging others to eat vegetables. In addition, pupils will write key facts about growing food and produce information leaflets about staying healthy and different trees and plants.

Maths

As part of our White Rose Maths programme, students will be learning about money, multiplication and division and length and height. Pupils will also continue working on place value, as well as addition and subtraction with larger numbers.

Music

Pupils will learn about different song forms; they will have the opportunity to compose their own song using ternary form. Pupils will have opportunities to develop their music technology skills using GarageBand.



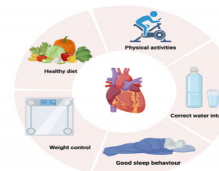
Art / DT

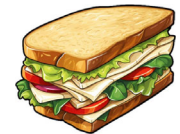
PSHE/RSE

This term, students will learn about mental wellbeing and health prevention, considering the impact on both their own lives and their families.



Preparation for Adulthood

This term for Preparation for Adulthood pupils will look at how to prepare meals, snacks and drinks in particular sandwiches so that they are able to increase their independence. We will also continue to work on our household skills such as washing and drying up.



Physical Education

Robin Class will explore a range of activities focused on athletic performance, including running, throwing, and jumping. They will also have the opportunity to design and develop their own fun games and challenges, helping to prepare exciting ideas for Sports Day.



Religious Education

Our RE focus for terms 5 and 6 will be 'What makes some places sacred?' We will be visiting a local church and the Gudwara temple in Gravesend for our students to have a multi sensory experience and to have a positive contribution to their local community.



Computing

Robin Class will explore 'Creating Media,' developing skills across a range of areas and including photo editing whilst working towards completing tasks independently.



Careers

In Careers we will learning about our employment rights and contracts. We will be developing our understanding of how agreements, like contracts, help people at work.
