## Literacy and Phonics

In Literacy we will continue to develop our phonics and spelling skills. This term we will be looking at a range of books linked to different transport. 'Lost and Found. By Oliver Jeffers' and 'The Train Ride by June Crebbin'. We will also be engaging in non fiction texts, writing fact files about different modes of transport.



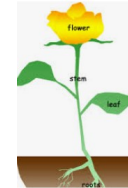
## Maths

In Maths we will be learning about fractions of shapes and number and engaging in looking at time. We will continue to develop our number skills and recap previous learning. We will continue to develop the use of manipulatives to support learning and to engage in problem solving questions.



## Science

This term in Science we will be learning about plants. Pupils will be exploring different plants and identifying a variety of common wild and garden plants. We will be looking at the structure of plants identifying and naming different parts.



## Computing

This term we will be continuing to learn about how to be safe online, looking at information sharing and the different types of information that can and cannot be shared online. We will also be engaging in programming and how to create animations using different programmes.



## Art and Design & Technology

In Art, Design & Technology this term we will be engaging in a project to design, create and make a boat testing and using different materials

Pupils will also be looking at creating a scene from what we see from a train window based on the book 'The Train Ride'.



## History

In History, this term we will be finding out about how transport and travel has changed over the past 100 years including how important Chatham Dockyard was to the local community e.g. trade, jobs etc. We will be comparing different modes of transport past and present.



## PSHE (Personal, social and health education) and RSE

This term we will be looking at physical health and mental health/wellbeing and the importance of it. We will also be looking at first aid and medicine.



## Physical Education

This term pupils will continue to develop their skills exploring a range of activities focused on athletic performance, including running, throwing, and jumping. They will also have the opportunity to design and develop their own fun games and challenges, helping to prepare exciting ideas for Sports Day.



## Religious Education

This term in RE we will continue learn about people who are special to us, whom we admire. We will discuss what makes these people special and identify these qualities.

## PE Enrichment

The pupils will have PE Enrichment on a Thursday morning and we will be engaging in ice skating this term. Please ensure pupils have warm clothing and gloves for this activity.



## Music

Pupils will have the opportunity to continue to develop their keyboard skills and continue to learn the *Harry Potter* theme following notation. Pupils will develop their listening skills to identify and name melodic patterns.
