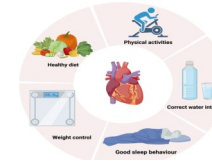
Art

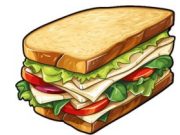
PSHE/RSE

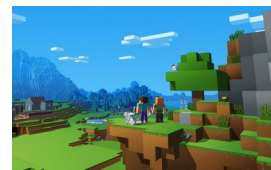
Religious Education
