

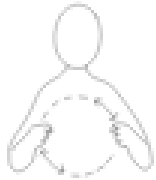

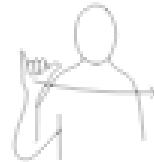

General Information

Welcome back to our last term this academic year, Term 6! This term our topic is 'Getting There'. Our core text being 'Let's Go for a Walk' by Hamza Yassin and 'We'll Go Travelling By'. Through the core text, students will be prompted to spot colours, shapes, textures, and sounds in their surroundings, helping to build observation skills and curiosity about the world around them.

Communication & Interactions

We will be personalising speech and language targets to facilitate early communication with a range of partners, This will take place through: The Curiosity Programme, Attention Autism, Tac Pac, Intensive interaction and visits to the Rainbow Room and Sensory Room.

PSED/Citizenship/RSE

Our topic this term is on health and prevention. We will be focusing on beginning to develop an understanding of things that may be bad for our body e.g. smoking.



Understanding the World

Students will have the opportunity matching a familiar hardware to picture e.g. printer, tablet, games console and begin to being able to make a choice over which device they use or which programme they want.

English

Students will continue to develop their communication through Objects of Reference, PECS, Makaton, Communication boards and switches. Students will continue to develop their fine motor, mark-making through a range of activities, including messy mark making, Dough Disco, sensory trays, drawings, posters and labels. We will have story sessions daily including story sacks and sensory stories. Each student will share a story with an adult either 1:1 or in a small group.

Our learning will focus on opportunities to give meaning to some environmental signs and symbols e.g. signs for toilet at park, reading symbols on individual timetables and writing names when creating our own passport and bus pass.

Physical Education:

This term, pupils will continue preparing for Sports Day by becoming familiar with key movements and target-based games they will take part in. Through practice and repetition, they will build confidence, coordination, and understanding of the activities in a supportive and enjoyable environment.



PE Enrichment

Every Tuesday morning we will have swimming during lesson 1 and 2. Please ensure that your child has their swimming kit.

On a Thursday morning we will be having Rebound Therapy (trampolining) in our school Sports Hall.

Preparing for Adulthood

We will be continuing our weekly visit to Ifield Life. This will provide a realistic and thoroughly enjoyable learning experience with a clear emphasis on developing independence as part of the Ifield Life Programme. Our focused learning will be on washing, bathing and bathroom routines

Employability

This term, we will be focusing on acting appropriately within the community, following symbols to locate items in the community e.g. find the swing in the park and find the toilet in an unfamiliar environment.

Maths

Our learning will focus on counting, 1:1 correspondence, grouping sets of familiar objects e.g. cars, planes, trains, colour and following a timetable and routine. There will be a variety of opportunities to explore these concepts as part of our learning time and our continuous provision.

Music

Every week we have a music lesson and Gong Therapy session. Pupils will have the opportunity to continue to explore tuned instruments and coloured notation to create their own melodies. They will use coloured symbols to identify key notes within an octave.
