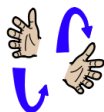

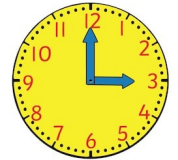
Attention Autism/ Communication

Students are taking part in Attention Autism sessions to expand on attention and engagement. Students are completing up to Stage 4. Pupils will be using sentence builders using colourful semantics and choice boards to expand their communication this term.



Foundations for Maths

Time - Recognise the daily routine. Read o'clock and half past on an analogue and digital clock. Shape - identify common 2D and 3D shapes. Match shapes in every day objects. Make shapes using dough. Money skills using the college shop.



Topic

Our topic is 'Moving On'. Some students will be preparing to leave Ifield 6th Form and help to arrange the prom. Transitions may take place if moving to a different provision.



Foundations for Literacy

Make a list of jobs for the prom. Write an invitation to the prom. Use capital letters and full stops. Use an adjective and a noun in a sentence when describing class texts.



Preparation for Adulthood

On a Wednesday students will be making picnic recipes such as sandwiches, wraps, salads and flapjacks. Diamond class will be practising using utensils such as knives, toaster, kettle and a blender.



Digital Skills
