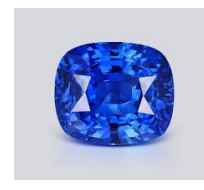

Students will continue to develop their spoken and written communication and will be working towards their ASDAN and English Functional Skills qualifications.

This term our topic is moving on. Students will be able to share experiences about moving on throughout their lives and learn about peer experiences and be able to evaluate their own.

We will also be researching a variety of community and nationwide events. This will help us to devise and plan our own event, which the students will present.

We will continue to improve our spelling, grammar and punctuation and those that need to, will sit for their speaking and listening assessments in English.

Qualification Work

All of our students will now have completed their 4 ASDAN units and can now peruse and select at least 1 ASDAN Life Skills Challenge to complete this term.

This can be associated with any of their prior learning or a topic or activity they are interested in.

Maths

During our Maths lessons we will be using the White-Rose Maths curriculum and resources. We will be able to use a range of manipulatives to help us and these will suit the individual needs of the each student.

This term we will be learning about data and how we can display and interpret it. We will be using a range of different apps that we could use to help use understand data.

We will learn how to draw a range of tables and charts and how we can use these in every day life.



We will continue to learn about averages, concentrating on the mean and the range and how we can use them throughout our lives.

The choices include Art, Music, walking, bowling and swimming.

Options

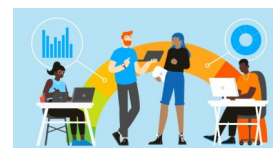
Students choose and study one of the following options:

Digital Skills:
