# Homework/Extension Step 5: Find Durations of Time 

## National Curriculum Objectives:

## Differentiation:

Questions 1, 4 and 7 (Varied Fluency)
Developing Draw the minute hand on a clock to reflect a duration of time. Using times that start at o'clock, half past and quarter to/past, durations of 15 minutes and within the hour. Expected Draw the minute hand on a clock to reflect a duration of time. Using durations that are multiples of 5 and within the hour.
Greater Depth Draw the minute hand on a clock to reflect a duration of time. Using durations that are multiples of 5 and pass through the hour.

Questions 2, 5 and 8 (Varied Fluency)
Developing Tick the correct time it would be after a duration has passed. Using times that start at o'clock, half past and quarter to/past, durations of 15 minutes and within the hour. Expected Tick the correct time it would be after a duration has passed. Using durations that are multiples of 5 and within the hour.
Greater Depth Tick the correct time it would be after a duration has passed. Using durations that are multiples of 5 and pass through the hour.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Reasoning and Problem Solving)
Developing Explain whether an afternoon timetable is correct. Using times that start at o'clock, half past and quarter to/past, durations of 15 minutes and within the hour. Expected Explain whether an afternoon timetable is correct. Using durations that are multiples of 5 and within the hour.
Greater Depth Explain whether an afternoon timetable is correct. Using durations that are multiples of 5 and pass through the hour.

9. Lacey-Mae wants to watch 3 football matches that will each be 45 minutes long. She plans her afternoon.

|  | Start time | End time |
| :--- | :---: | :---: |
| Football match 1 | 2 o'clock | quarter to 3 |
| Football match 2 | quarter to 3 | half past 3 |
| Football match 3 | half past 3 | quarter to 4 |



Is she correct? Explain your answer.

## Developing

1. Minute hand pointing to 3 (quarter past 10).
2. Quarter past 2.
3. Safia is incorrect because she would finish cutting hair at quarter to 2 .

## Expected

4. Minute hand pointing to 6 (half past 5).
5. Five minutes to 4.
6. Chik is incorrect because she has written the duration of worksheet 2 as 25 minutes to 4 instead of 20 minutes to 4 . Worksheet 3 would start at 20 minutes to 4.

## Greater Depth

7. Minute had pointing to 5 ( 25 minutes past 3 ).
8. Five minutes past 8.
9. Lacey-Mae is incorrect because football match 3 would start at half past 3 and end at quarter past 4.
