Jesus said that Peter would deny Him before the cock crows.



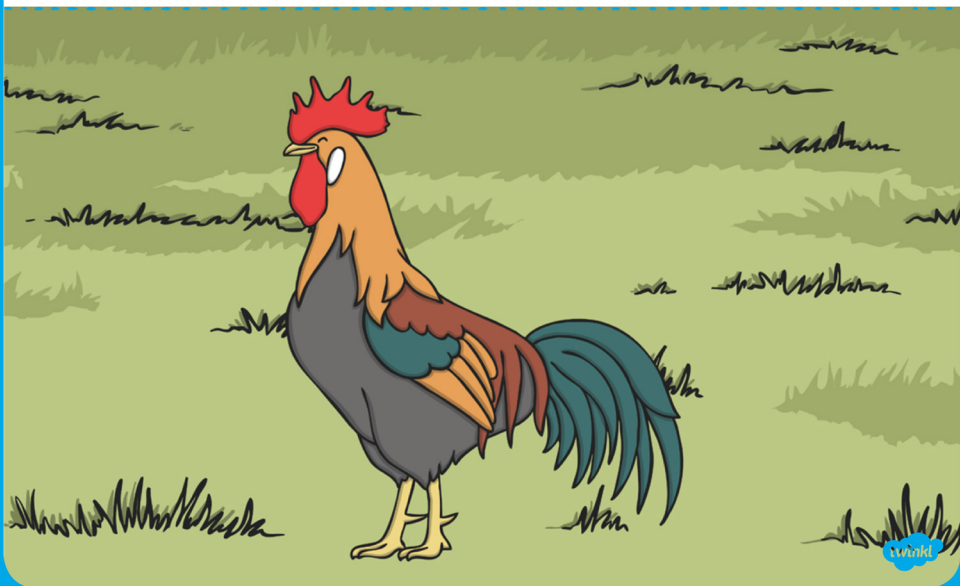
Judas told the high priests where Jesus was and they sent the temple guards.



Peter said he didn't know Jesus.



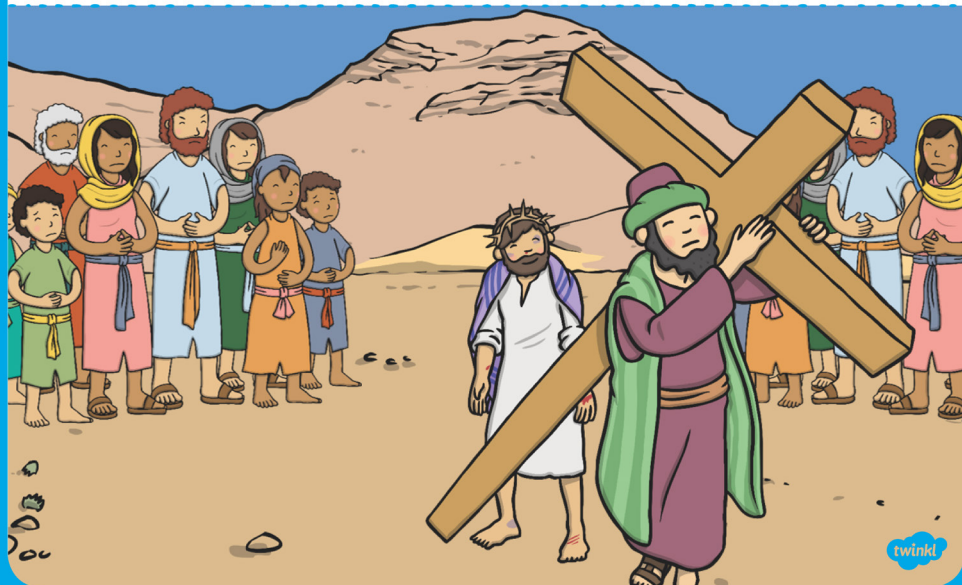
The cock crowed.



Pontius Pilate set Barabbas free instead of Jesus.



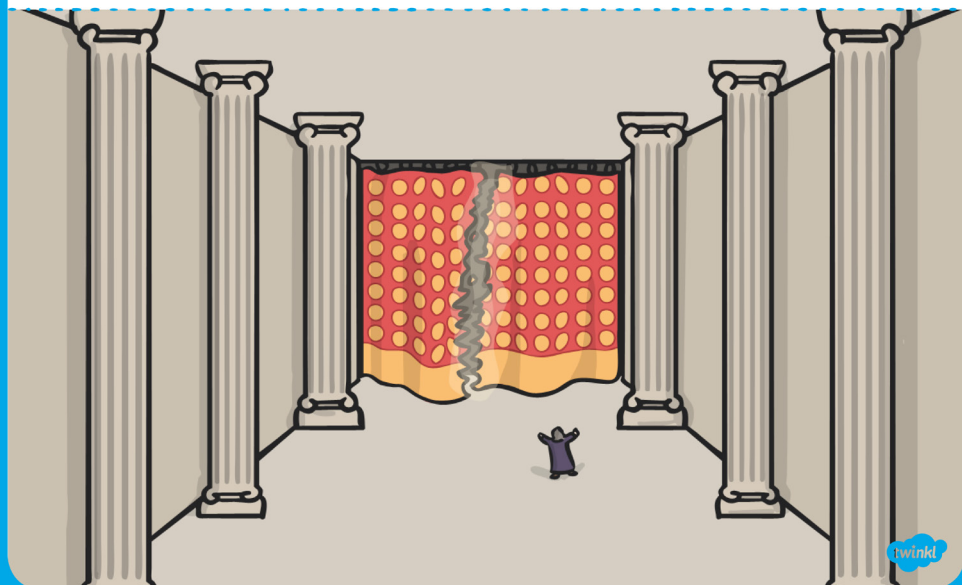
Simon carried Jesus' cross to the hill.



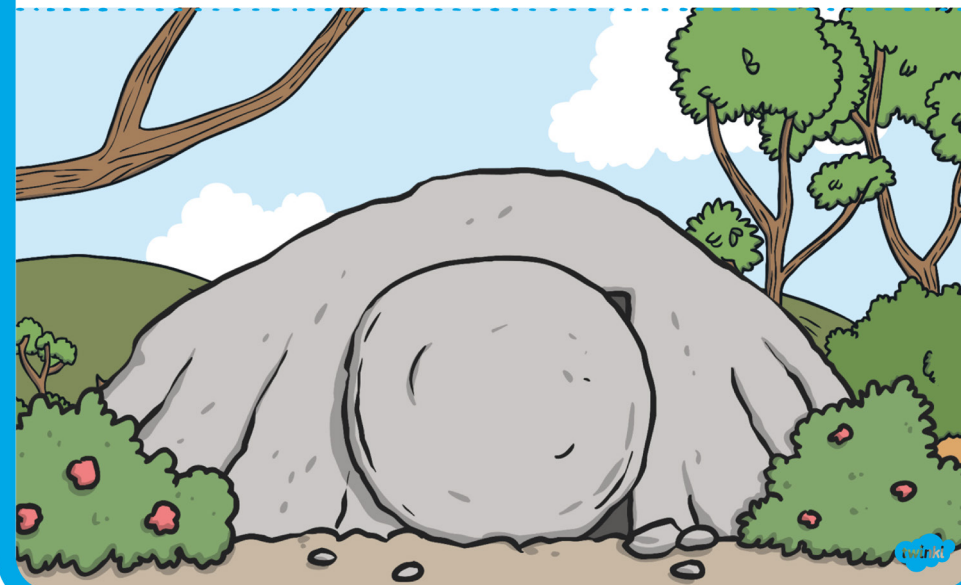
Jesus was crucified.
