

Felt Sea Creatures

Supplies

- Several colours of felt
- Googly eyes
- Ribbon
- Strong glue
- Glue stick
- Corrugated card
- Blue and Green paint



- Pencil
- Scissors
- Sea Creature Templates
- Sand paper





First, make the background for the picture. Start by painting the sheet of corrugated card in blue and leave to dry.



Now make the felt sea creatures for the picture. To do this, cut out the sea creature templates and draw around them onto felt sheets using a black felt tip pen.



Next, carefully cut out the felt creatures.



Now decorate the sea creatures. To do this, glue on googly eyes, pieces of felt or jewels and sequins as desired.



Once the blue corrugated card has dried, decorate it with sections of glitter. To do this, spread PVA glue in sections onto the card, then sprinkle glitter onto the glue. Leave to dry.



Now cut 3 or 4 lengths of ribbon slightly longer than the length of the corrugated card. Attach the sea creatures at evenly spaced points on the lengths of ribbon, using strong glue.



Now make a layer of sand for the bottom of the picture. To do this, take a strip of corrugated card that is the same width as the main piece. Draw a slightly wiggly line along the card, than cut out.



Now tear up pieces of sand paper and stick them onto the bottom of the cardboard to form a layer of sand. Neaten the edges up using scissors.



Glue the sand onto the bottom of the blue card. Then stick the sea creatures onto your picture by fixing the top and bottom of each ribbon to the back of the card using tape. Try to space the ribbons out equally.



10 Make a layer of seaweed for the picture. To do this, cut out wavy or ziq-zaq strips of cardboard and paint them green.



11 Glue the strips of seaweed onto the picture, so that they cover the ends of the ribbon.



Felt Sea Creatures



Supplies

- Several colours of felt

Step 6. Now cut 3 or 4 lengths of ribbon slightly longer than the length of the corrugated card. Attach the sea creatures at evenly spaced points on the lengths of ribbon, using strong glue.

Step 8. Now tear up pieces of sand paper and stick them onto the cardboard to form a layer of sand. Neaten the edges up using scissors.



Step 9. Glue the sand onto the bottom of the blue card. Then stick the sea creatures onto your picture by fixing the top and bottom of each ribbon to the back of the card using tape. Try to space the ribbons out equally.



Step 10. Make a layer of seaweed for the picture. To do this, cut out wavy or zig-zag strips of cardboard and paint them green.



Step 11. Glue the strips of seaweed onto the picture, so that they cover the ends of the ribbon.
