Snow drift	Cracking foot gel.	Massage feet or hands.
Snow storm	Paper snowballs, confetti.	Throw scrunched up snow balls or confetti in the air above students.
River	Cold water, deep trays.	Where possible students to put feet in cold water.
Icicles	Ice cubes.	Drip ice cubes on faces/hands.
Snow cave	Echoing microphones.	Call and response for names.
Cave	Torches, mirrors.	Use torches to look around room, look at own faces, track lights.
BEAR!	Blankets, Thunder drum or bear sound on computer.	Quick drum beat/tapping. Reverse through activities. Hide under blankets. Bear growling sound on CD or
