

A sentence is a group of words which are connected to each other and it makes sense by itself.

Sentences



What you need to remember when writing a sentence:

- The **letters** need to be the same size.
- The **letters** need to be written the right way round.
- The **letters** should sit on the line.
- There should be a finger space between each word.
- A sentence should start with a capital letter.
- Special names should start with capital letters.
- A sentence should end with a full stop.
- A sentence should always make sense.
