LO I can explain how to travel safely to town on the bus

### Challenge

Scenario: You have to travel to Asda on your own using public transport. You will need to think about the following things when you are planning your journey.

- Make sure you know where you are going.
- Find out how to get there.
- Check the details of how you will travel (transport type, times, costs, etc.)
- Make sure you have your travel pass or money to buy tickets.
- Make sure you take some form of identification with you.
- Let someone know where and when you will be travelling.
- Make your journey a safe one.
