

How can I use this with my children?

This booklet contains a range of fun activities you can use with your child to encourage them to count one more and one less. It includes a dice game, sweet counting and number line activities.

How does this help my children's learning?

In year 1, your child will be taught how to identify one more and one less than a given number. The activities in the pack will help them practise this key national curriculum learning objective.

Ideas for further learning:

Roll two dice. Ask your child to add the two numbers together and write their answer down. Can they tell you what is one more and one less than their answer? For an extra challenge, ask them to tell you what is two more and two less than their answer.








Number Rockets: One More






Number Rockets: One More






Number Rockets: One Less







In the boxes, write one less and one more than the number shown on each sweet.









One More, One Less: Dice Game


Instructions


