Imaginary Creatures Description Game

Instructions

Begin by laying all of the cards face up on a table where all the players can see them.

Choose one player to start the game. Keeping the cards on the table, the player thinks of one of the pictures for the other players to try to identify.

The other players then take turns to ask questions to identify the chosen creature. For example, they may ask: "Does this creature have wings?" or "Is this creature blue?"

When a player thinks they are able to identify the chosen creature, they pick up the card and ask if they are correct. If they are correct, this player can then choose a creature for others to identify. If incorrect, the card is placed back on the table and play continues until the creature is correctly identified.
