Food Technology

LO: To be able to use electrical kitchen aid safely. Starter

Starter

The children are going to practice their spreading skills when making toast and jam. Before starting discuss safety and hygiene when cooking.

Activity

Discuss what is needed to make toast and jam. Prepare the ingredients and equipment needed. Support children to safely use the toaster. Then spread the butter and a topping on the toast. Encourage them to cut the toast in half. They can eat their toast or they can put it in a sandwich bag for snack time.

LO: To be able to write instructions

Starter

Remind children about the process for making toast and jam. What did they need? What order did they do things in? Encourage them to verbalise their answers.

Share the lesson how to write instructions presentation. Talk about the organisation of the instructions for the recipe sheet. Talk about the following:

An imperative verb can be referred to as a 'bossy' verb e.g. cut, fold, mix, stir, whisk.

An adverb modifies a verb by giving more information e.g. carefully, slowly, quickly, gently.

A time conjunction signals the passing of time and the order of events e.g. first, next then, after that, finally.
