Activity

Using the New Year Tradition Cards, lay them all out on a table face down and take turns to pick a card. Act out some of the traditions using the gathered resources.

LO: To create a range of different line & textures

Starter

Share images and videos of New Years celebrations including fireworks – discuss the colours, and shapes created in the displays.

Activity

Design and make a firework scene using different tools to create a variety of lines. Use a variety of colours layered together (let one layer dry before adding the next colour to ensure the colours stay vibrant) Before all the paint has dried sprinkle a thin layer of glitter over the artwork.

Resources

Black paper or card (if not available use white)

Brightly coloured paints

Paintbrushes

Any other found tools that can be used to paint with:

Cotton buds, forks, toilet roll cardboard cut part way into thin strips, wool, twigs etc
