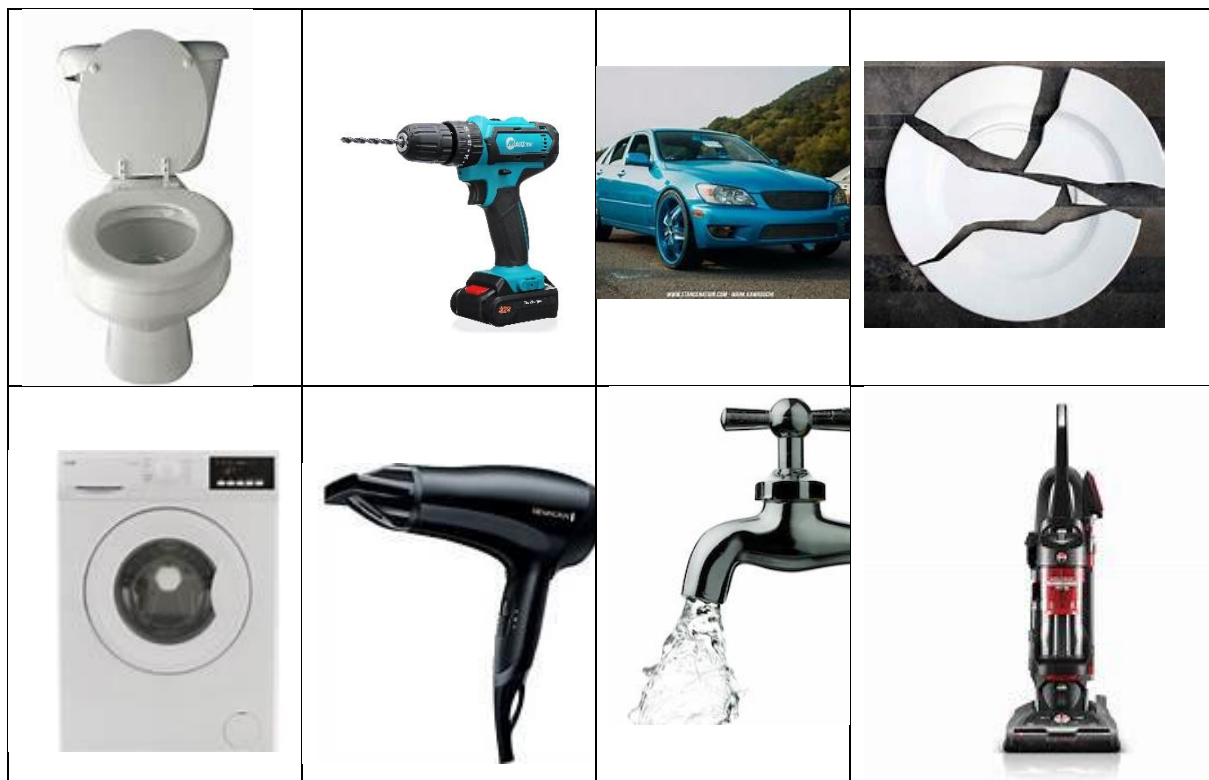


Sensory home learning activities 18/01/21
