To start, you will need to decide if you want to make your own box out of a

cube net, or if you want to use something already in the home as your base.

Once you have the outer layer to protect 'Dorothy' you will need to think about the materials you could use inside the house to keep her safe and unhurt.

You can use whatever materials you have around the house and you can decorate it once you have finished too!



The test...

You will need to be able to drop Dorothy's house from a height and the egg inside needs to stay intact without any cracks or breaks – remember; this is Dorothy who is in your house and she doesn't want to get hurt in any way.
