Make mosaic art with this Roman soldier template to support learning about the Romans.

How does this help my children's learning?

Using scissors to cut out shapes and gluing them in position may encourage hand-eye coordination and creativity.

Ideas for further learning:

Why not create a Romans-inspired mosaic tile together with some broken tile pieces?



Make a Roman Soldier Mosaic





You will need:

- Roman soldier template
- coloured paper
- scissors
- glue



Instructions

1. Print out (or draw) a side profile of a Roman soldier.
2. Cut up a variety of squares from the coloured paper. (You could cut the paper into strips of equal width. Then, fold the strips to create the first square. Repeat this fold to mark out squares along the strip of paper and then cut along the folds.)
3. Position the squares to form a mosaic.
4. Once you're happy with your design, begin to glue the squares onto the template.
5. Leave a little gap between each piece of paper.



Alternatives to try:

- Use similar colours for each section. For example, use a range of reds and oranges for the feathers then blues and silvers for the helmet.
- Design your own mosaic pattern to fill other shapes.






Ancient Rome Paper Model Soldier
