
LI: I can consolidate my skills on measurement (capacity and volume).

In class we have done a lot of work on measuring using our measuring jugs. Can you fill the jugs on the next page to the correct point, using your colouring pencils?


If you finish this, you can carry on filling out your measurement table, this time using measuring jugs and your ruler to measure different volumes and lengths!








Phonics




Life Skills




