

KENT CORE - SPEECH, LANGUAGE & COMMUNICATION NEEDS IN THE MAINSTREAM PRIMARY CLASSROOM

Workshop Objectives:

This one-day workshop will focus on speech, language and communication difficulties and how they affect performance across the curriculum and beyond. Attendees will learn about strategies for supporting students with a range of speech, language and communication needs (SLCN) – the most common SEN need type.

Workshop Content:

Participants will learn how to identify and support students with speech, language and communication difficulties in school:

- Gain an understanding of the range (and jargon) of SLCN as identified by health professionals or through school's own observation and tracking systems
- Explore a range of strategies and resources to facilitate the development of language and communication skills in children and young people
- Become familiar with good SLCN practice as detailed in Kent's Mainstream Core Standards document
- Explore practical strategies and ideas to support learning, social and emotional needs and ongoing language development.
